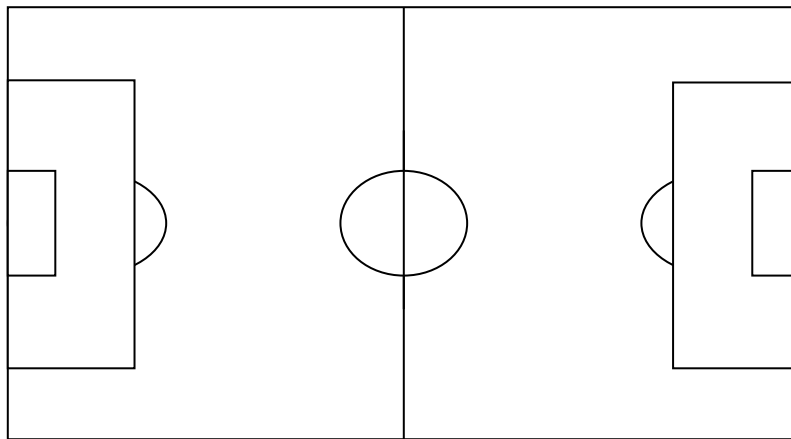

The incident occurred 47 minutes into the game and was as follows:

**John Smith from Apples team received a caution in the match for dissent from the referee at the 34<sup>th</sup> minute. In the 47<sup>th</sup> minute Smith was cautioned again for dissent towards the officiating crew once the ball had left the field of play. Smith was shown a second yellow card for his dissent and then shown a red card for receiving a second yellow, at this point he collected his belongings and left the field. Play restarted with a throw-in from where it had left the field.**
