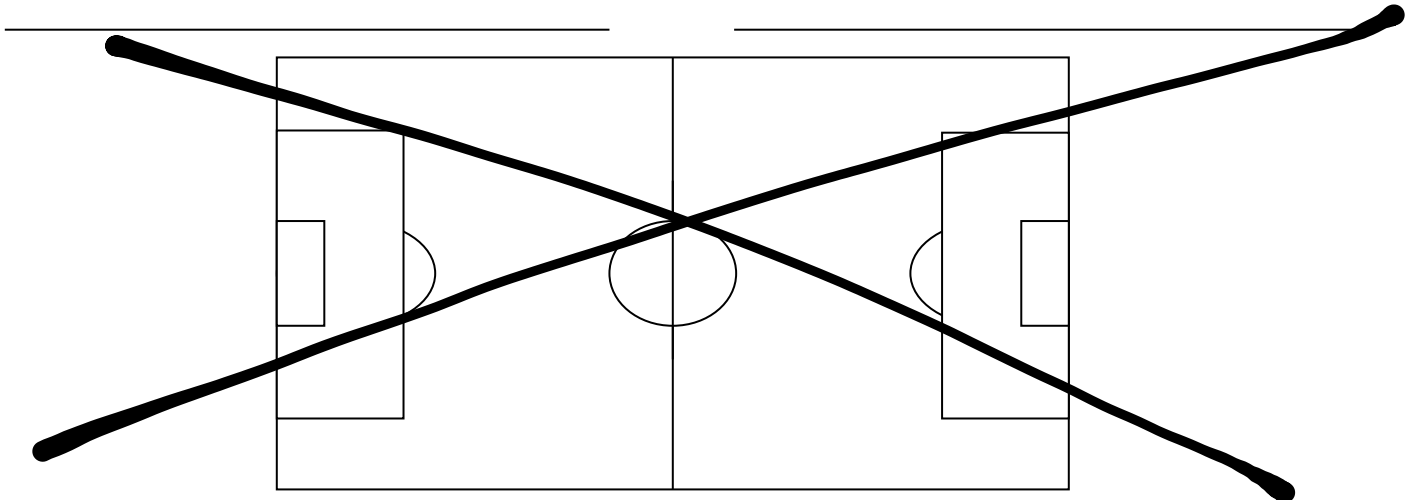
The incident occurred after the match minutes into the game and was as follows:

**At the conclusion of the match a spectator from the Bananas FC team approached the referee to address and injury that occurred in the match. As he got closer to the referee, he stated “do you know we don’t have a doctor.” At this point the referee reminded the spectator that he was not permitted to approach the referee after the match to discuss the game, and that he needed to walk away. He was told several times, but he continued to stand there arguing back at the referee, “I am not going anywhere”, the referee then asked the rest of the Bananas FC team to step and pull the spectator away, the coaches and other parents did nothing and just stood there watching the situation. At this point the referee began to yell at the spectator that he was being dismissed and needed to walk away, he refused yet again and continued to argue with the referee. The referee while maintaining their distance began to blow their whistle in the spectator’s face to get him to leave, at this point the coaches from the Apples team intervened and began to reason with the spectator that he needed to leave and that his behaviour was unacceptable. It was only at this point did the other spectators from the Banana FC side engage, but they just argued with the Apples bench about the referee’s performance and that the use of the whistle was unjustified. After a few moments the two sides calmed down and the spectator in question was pulled away by another Banana FC spectator and a player.**

**The referee for safety reasons walked to their vehicle with the coaches of the Apples team because the spectator remained in the area.**
